Conditions of use.

The GME MT410G Personal Locator Beacon should only be used when there is a threat of grave and imminent danger.

The information provided on this form will be entered by the Canberra Alpine Club Personal Locator Beacon (PLB) Loan Officer or delegate, on the Australian Maritime Safety Authority (AMSA) website and may assist Search and Rescue authorities locate your position in the event of an activation in an emergency.

If you suspect that the PLB has been activated inadvertently, you must turn it off and report it immediately to the AMSA Rescue Co-ordination Centre on **1800 641 792** to ensure a costly search and rescue operation is not commenced. This phone number is noted on a sticker on the body of the unit. When reporting an inadvertent activation you should include the following: a) the PLB 15 character Unique Identifier number marked on the unit body; b) date, time and duration of activation; c) cause of activation; and d) location of activation.

There is no penalty for a genuine accidental activation.

Failure to return by the stated time will NOT automatically result in Emergency Services being notified by the Canberra Alpine Club PLB Loan Officer or any other Club officials or members. It is your responsibility to brief a responsible person, not part of the trip party, on the details of the trip. This person will be responsible for notifying Emergency Services in the event that you are overdue.

Neither Canberra Alpine Club nor its officers or members will be liable for any failure of the PLB, injury, damage or costs associated with the use of this PLB.

Club officials conduct regular maintenance and testing of the PLB. Persons borrowing the PLB will not be required to conduct tests of the units.

If the PLB is not returned or is returned damaged, regardless of fault, you may be charged a replacement cost of up to \$600.
